Assign $\geq 10\%$ of Student Grades to Connect

Integrate Connect into Your Syllabus

Encourage Students to Register on Day One

Students who access digital materials on Day 1 vs. Day 7 earn average scores of **81%** and **75%**, respectively. And those who wait three weeks to register are **1.3x** more likely to fail.* **Walk students through the Connect registration process – every student can register on the first day of class with the 14-day free trial (or with the purchase of an access code).**

Bonus Tip: When students register with their access code, make sure they double check their 1/ones and 0/zeros to ensure they enter their code correctly.

Ensure Successful Connect and LMS Syncing

If you're pairing your course with your learning management system (LMS), like Blackboard, Canvas, or D2L, auto grade-sync simplifies students' assignment access and ensures that your gradebooks are always up-to-date. **Just make sure your students know to register for Connect using the same first and last name that your institution has on file.**

5

Review Student Registrations

Log in to your Connect account, navigate to your section roster and view which students have yet to successfully register. If using an LMS, check that your students' accounts are synced so they won't miss important assignments. **Don't forget to remind students during class to upgrade their free trial before it expires, and to complete the Connect assignments.**

6

Create a Consistent Assignment Cadence

Consistency is the key to academic performance, helping students stay on top of their coursework and complete assignments on time. Schedule assignments on the same day and time each week to promote consistency. **For example, make all assignments due on Sundays at 11:59 PM.**

Bonus Tip: Reduce noon/midnight confusion by making assignments due dates at 11:59 PM.
