These elements help ensure that it is efficiently designed and will teach the maximum amount of material in the shortest amount of time.

2. With systematic, explicit, and efficient instruction, students can master material more quickly and become more self-confident learners. Direct Instruction programs, developed by Siegfried Engelmann and colleagues, incorporate all of these elements of effective instruction. The programs are developed in a careful procedure that involves extensive logical analysis of the subject matter and strategies for testing the programs before they are published. These tests ensure that the programs are clear and explicit and that they efficiently present the material.

Years of research on how children learn show that even minor alterations in instructional presentations can produce confusion and slow children's learning. Direct Instruction programs include extensive guidelines for teachers in how to present the material in ways that are logical, clear, and systematic and in ways that consistently reinforce children in their learning.
