1 Activating Prior Knowledge

Write these words on the board and have students tell how many vowels and syllables are in each: *after* (2, 2), *jacket* (2, 2), and *author* (3, 2).

2 Introducing the Lesson

Tell students that some words, called compound words, can be divided into smaller words. Write the word *afternoon* on the board and say, "Here is a long word. If I sound this word out, it will take a long time, so I'm going to see if there are smaller words inside it." Underline *after* and *noon* and read the two words. Repeat with the words *copyright* and *waterfall*. Then read aloud the information in the ALL-STAR Readers Know box on page 77.

3 Guided Practice

Write the word *sun* on the board and tell students that some words are used in many compound words. Write the words *sunlight* and *sunrise*; then instruct students to name other compound words that begin with *sun* (*sunburst*, *Sunday*, *sunset*). Then read these words and have students signal thumbs-up if it is a compound word and thumbs-down if it is not:
