Paid Professional Learning

Delivered by practitioners in Australia, paid Professional Learning is conducted by professional trainers with extensive classroom experience using DI programs. All partner trainers meet McGraw Hill's professional learning standards and have a minimum of two years' experience delivering DI. These facilitators ensure schools are trained to implement DI programs with fidelity and success.

Options 1 and 2 (Full Day and Half Day) are designed to be delivered onsite, either at your school or at a designated training location located as close as possible to your school. However, parts of the training such as scheduled check-ins can be delivered remotely if preferred.

Options 3 and 4 (Full Day Package Online and Half Day Package Online) are designed for schools that prefer the flexibility of online delivery, including those in remote locations.

Option 5 (Booster Package Online) is a focused workshop designed to revisit key teaching techniques, strengthen instructional delivery and address specific implementation needs.

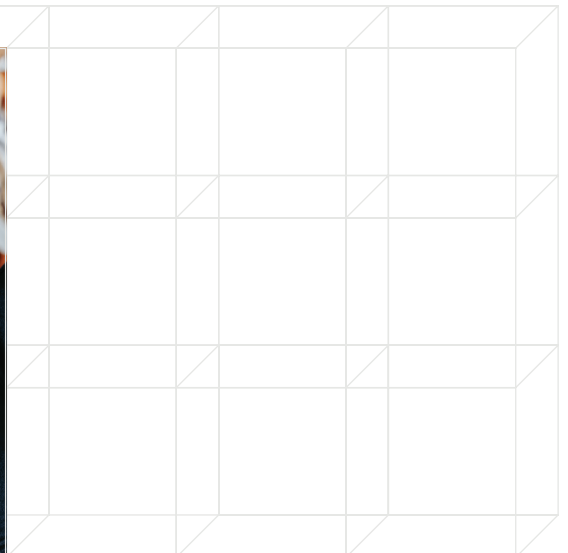

Scheduling Guidelines and Policies

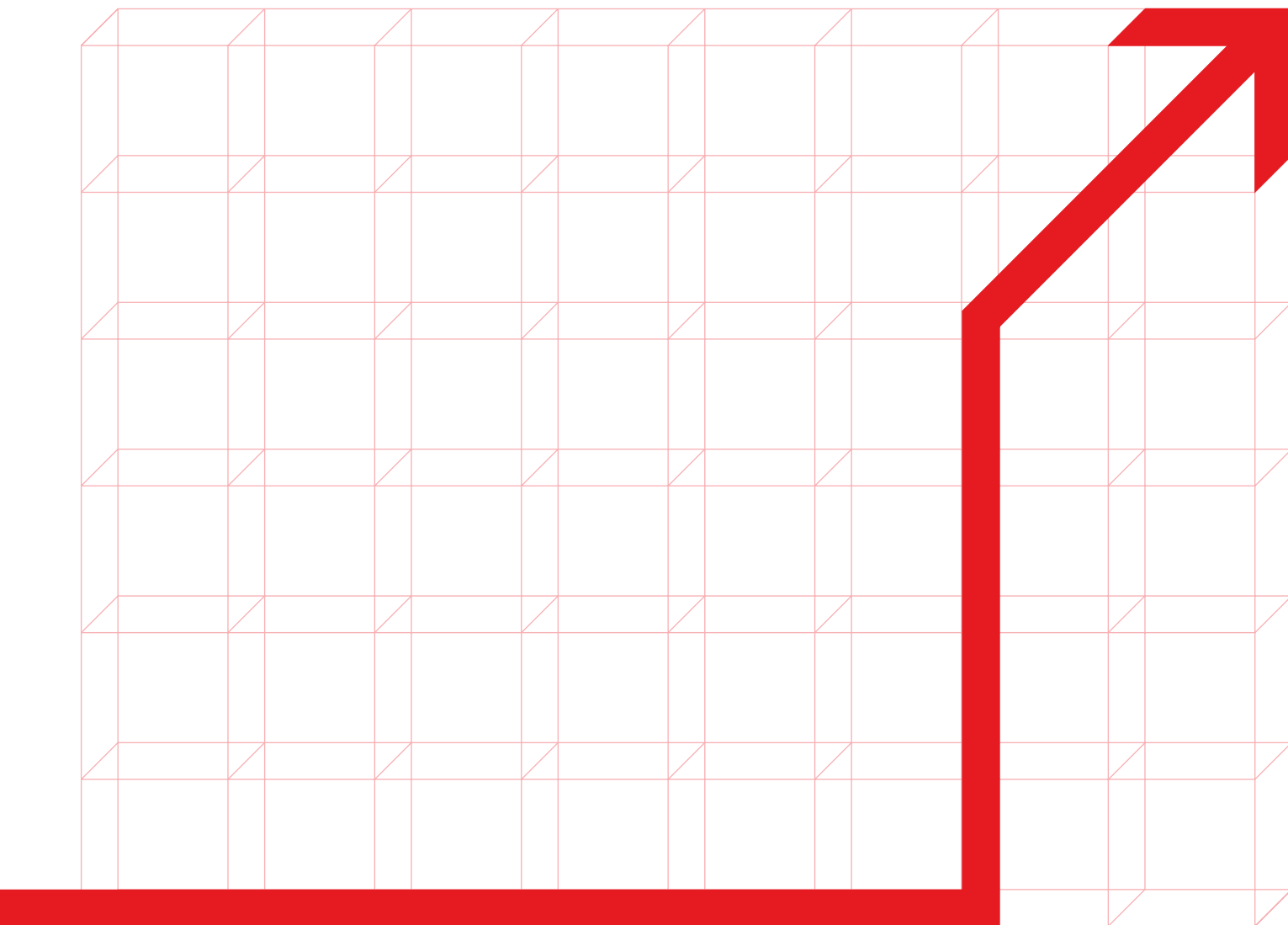
- All training sessions must be booked through your McGraw Hill Learning Solutions Consultant. Your consultant will work with you to determine the best training package to suit your needs, school size and location.
- A booking form will be completed by you to confirm the training package and preferred dates for the training.
- Training will be invoiced once the booking form has been signed by both parties.
- Sessions can be scheduled to suit your school - either spread over multiple afternoons or combined into one full-day session for convenience.
- We will do our best to accommodate your preferred dates, but may not always be able to meet exact dates based on availability of trainers. In-person training is not available in all states due to trainer availability.
- Where a specified date/dates cannot be met, we will work with you to find an alternative.

Lead Times:

- On-site: at least 30 business days (minimum 15).
- Virtual: at least 20 business days (minimum 10).
- Cancellation and Rescheduling Policy:
 - On-site training cancelled within 7 business days cannot be rescheduled.
 - Virtual training cancelled within 2 business days cannot be rescheduled.
 - Cancellations made earlier will be rebooked on the next available date.
 - Weather or school closure cancellations will be rescheduled at no cost.
 - Professional Learning Days expire within 12 months for the In-Person Packages, and within 6 months for the Online Packages.

- Training is invoiced and paid through McGraw Hill.
- Travel costs may apply for non-metro trainers and will be itemised in your quote.
